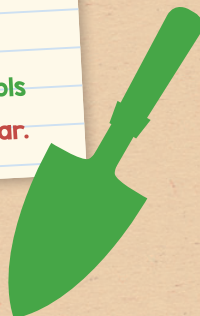
Come and see what our 2000m² plot looks like
